The Eastford Republican Town Committee is responsible for the promotion of candidates to run for public office.

The town committee is made up of fifteen registered Republicans. We meet on the third Tuesday of each month at the library in the meeting room on the main level. Our meetings are open to all registered Republicans who live in Eastford. Members are elected in an open caucus in January of even numbered years. We also caucus to elect delegates to attend various state conventions and to nominate candidates for town elections in odd numbered years. These caucuses are also open to all registered Republicans.

Throughout the year we hold various fundraisers not only to support our candidates but also to support our community. In the spring we sell roses in conjunction with Mother's Day. On Heritage Day we sell hot dogs and hamburgers and in the fall we have a dinner and a popular raffle, to which many townspeople and local businesses generously donate.

For many years we have donated funds to sponsor two Eastford children to attend the Day Camp at Crystal Pond for a week. We give financial support to community organizations like the Eastford Food Bank, the Nahaco Park Commission, and the Eastford Historical Society. We also contribute to the annual auction at Eastford Elementary School which raises money for the Eighth Grade Trip to Washington, D.C.
